WELLINGTON AFC Club History

Formed in 1892, we are proud to be a three-star FA Accredited Club and run more than 30 teams, providing football for hundreds of men, women, boys and girls throughout the season.

Initially, the club played in leagues based around Taunton and Tiverton. In the early 1960s, we gained promotion to the Somerset Senior League and succeeded in achieving Western League status in 1978 which has been retained ever since, making us one of the league's longest continuously serving members.

Since entering the Western League in the First Division, we have played at Premier Division level from 1981-82 to 1984-85 and 2008-09 to 2010-11. The team were then promoted as First Division champions at the end of the 2016-17 season and have since remained in the Premier Division.

In their first season back, the team finished a creditable 15th and also reached the semi-finals of the Somerset Premier Cup.

The side, who finished 15th in 2023-24, are now managed by Richard Cherry.

We have four other senior sides - the Reserves in the Devon and Exeter League's premier division, the A team in the Taunton Saturday League's premier division and the Ladies, who have two teams in the Somerset County Women's League.

We run 23 teams in our youth and minis with both boys and girls playing from the age of seven right through to 18 - along with coaching for even younger children.

We also have a thriving Disability section with two adult sides and two youth teams.

Off the pitch, Wellington AFC play a major role in the local community – we are home to a large number of skittles and darts teams and our social facilities are in use throughout the year for a wide range of events staged by local organisations, registered charities and individuals.

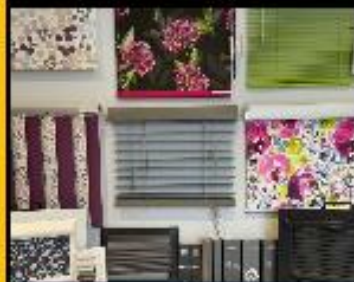

MATCH REPORT
Somerset Premier Cup – First Round
WELLINGTON 7 MIDDLEZOY ROVERS 0

New signing Charlie Wilson scored four goals on his debut as Wellington cruised into the second round of the premier cup at the Playing Field on Wednesday evening.

Manager Richard Cherry made three changes to the side which beat Paulton Rovers 2-0 on Saturday.

Young keeper Charlie Hawkings came in for the unwell Jake Viney, Wilson – who most recently played for Axminster Town – was out wide in place of Nathan Byrne, and Jake Mawford replaced the dual-registered Phil Mendonca who has joined Willand Rovers.

The Tangerines got off to a flying start with two goals in the opening 12 minutes.

They went ahead when Middlezoy keeper Ashley Hutchings parried the ball out for Rohan Poulsom to drive home his second goal in two games.

Four minutes later, it was 2-0 as Wilson caught Hutchings off his line and scored with a stunning lob from fully 40 yards.

To their credit, Middlezoy, of the South West Peninsula League, refused to lie down and they gave the hosts a couple of scares without being able to reduce the arrears before the break. But Wellington were rampant in the second half, scoring five times without reply.

Sub Josh Baker made it 3-0 with a superb header after 53 minutes and, ten minutes later, great work from another sub, Sam Bryant, left Wilson with a simple tap-in.

Shortly afterwards, Wilson completed his hat-trick with a second audacious goal, his rabona cross dropping in at the far post.

Bryant hit the post with a low drive before Wellington wrapped it up with a pair of late strikes.

Wilson made it six – and four for him – with another close-range finish before Mark Cornish headed home in stoppage time to complete the scoring.

There was even time a late appearance by Rob Hall, who came on in goal for Hawkings after being out injured for two years.

The result will boost the Tangerines' confidence as they return to league action this afternoon against Shepton Mallet.

TODAY'S VISITORS SHEPTON MALLET

Shepton Mallet Town FC originated from the amalgamation of three local teams in 1933, and who won the Somerset Senior League Premier Division Title in 1949, 1959, 1974 and 1975, as well as lifting the Somerset Senior Cup in 1950 and 1965.


Under manager Richard Fox the club were elected to the Western League for the first time in 1976, and promoted to the Premier Division as runners up in their first season. After relegation two years later, they again reached the Premier Division this time under manager Brian Drysdale, after winning the first division title in season 1981- 2, only for the original club to fold four years later and drop out of the Western League in 1986.

A new club named Shepton Mallet AFC was formed for season 1987-88 to compete in the Somerset County League, reaching the Premier Division in the early 1990s and winning the County Senior Cup in 1997-98 under manager Alan O'Leary. They finally won the league title in season 2000-2001 under manager Roger Smith to regain Western League status.

A dip in fortune followed, with two top 10 finishes followed by 9 seasons in the bottom half of the table, Kev Davis the longest serving manager in this period, Andy Jones and his assistant player manager Ben Cleverley were appointed in 2012 and in their second season the club gained promotion to the Premier Division (finishing 2nd behind Bradford Town) where they have remained since, and finishing in the top half of the table every season bar one.

Craig Loxton took over in 2016 and in 2018 the club finished 6th and lost the Les Phillips Cup Final to Buckland Athletic. After another 6th place finish in 2022 Craig left and in November 2022 Aaron Seviour was appointed, along with his assistant Matty Morris. Under Aaron the club has finished 8th, then last season 7th, but also reached the Les Phillips Cup final in both seasons. After losing to Helston Athletic in the 2023 final, the club made it third time lucky when they lifted the cup with a 3-1 win against Barnstaple Town to win their first trophy since 2001.

The current management team remains in place for the 2024-25 season along with most of last years successful squad of players.

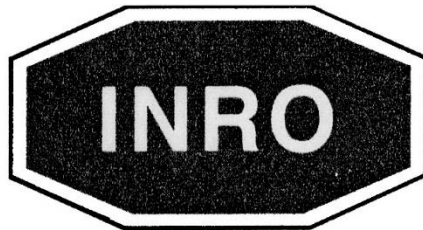

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS



As an FA Accredited Club, we expect all spectators to play your part and support the FA's Respect Code of Conduct at all times

- Respect the referee's decisions even when you don't agree with them
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Appreciate good play whatever team it comes from
- Support positively. When players make a mistake offer them encouragement not criticism
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language
- Never engage in threatening or violent behaviour
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated spectator's area

You must fully understand and readily accept that failure to comply with any of the above may result in you being:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have your membership removed

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
- Any physical assault on a Match Official will result in a lengthy or permanent exclusion from football and possibly a criminal prosecution
